

Terror charges brought against Indian Mujahideen operative in connection with 2010 Jama Masjid attack

Indian Mujahideen (IM) operative Fasih Mahmood, who was deported from Saudi Arabia last year, was on Saturday chargesheeted for the 2010 Jama Masjid attack.

Fasih has been charged with forgery and possession of fake bank notes and under the Explosive Substances Act and the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act.

Key 26/11 handler Abu Jundal and 13 other suspected IM men have already been charged in the case.

Fasih has been described as a recruiter for IM, which has been instrumental in carrying out a series of terror attacks across the country since 2008.

During his interrogation, Fasih revealed that he was one of the founding members of IM and was involved in its various activities, the police said in the charge-sheet filed in the court of additional sessions judge Asha Menon.
